1. (C) Map reference: SWN, 1:50,000, AMS L704, sheet nrs 6332 II, 6331 I, II, 6431 I, II, III, IV, 6432 II, III, 6531 IV.
2. (C) Technical Intelligence Summary.

a. On 281210H Nov 68, vic coord YH403799, Project Delta elms cptrd a 7.62 mm, semi-automatic carbine (SKS, SN 941921). Wpn is a standard issue semi-automatic carbine. Stamped on the left side of the receiver are M21 No 941921. The numbers 41921 are stamped on the operating rod, on the bolt, on the trigger housing, on the magazine, and on the stock. The numbers 88004 are stamped on the receiver cover. On the bottom of the breech, stamped in Russian, are Y 48 and 5. Stamped on the barrel, below the rear sight, are the letters S, G, and V. The weapon has a folding knife bayonet. Also cptrd were 3 7.62 mm cartridges (type 56) with head stamps 31/65, 31/66 and 31/67. Wpn was manufactured by Communist China. Remarks: According to the pamphlet "Soviet Bloc and Chinese Communist Infantry Weapons Markings", this is a sanitized version of a Chinese Communist Type 56 SaS. Some doubt as to this identification is raised by the presence of a blade type bayonet and a cyrillic Y on one of the parts.

b. On 050900H Dec 68, vic coord YH322545, Project Delta elms cptrd a 7.62 mm ChiCom assault rifle, type 56 (SN 9005132). Wpn is a standard issue assault rifle of late version. Stamped on the left side of the receiver are the numbers 66 in a triangle, three Chinese characters and the serial nr 5132 is stamped on rear of receiver cover. 5132 and the ltr O are stamped on the operating rod. 5132, O, and 4 are stamped on the recoil spring guide. The ltr O is stamped on bottom of the bolt, forward of the fire selector, are two Chinese characters and the ltrs K, A, and B. The ltr K is stamped below the fire selector. 121D is stamped at the rear of the upper hand guard. The rifle has no bayonet (snap on type). Also cptrd were 63 type 56, 7.62 mm cartridges with head stamps as follows: 31/63, 31/64, 31/65, 31/66, 31/58, 18/65, and 61/62. Wpn was manufactured by Communist China.

c. On 081445H Dec 68, vic coord YH463457, Project Delta elms cptrd a 7.62 mm, type 56, assault rifle (SN 11045797). Wpn is a standard issue assault rifle of late version. Stamped on the left side of the receiver are the numbers 66 in a triangle, three Chinese characters, and the serial number. The numbers 45797 are stamped on rear of the receiver cover, left side of bolt carrier, and recoil spring guide. O is stamped on bottom of the bolt and T is stamped on the right side of the bolt. S is stamped on the fire selector and L and D are stamped fwd of the selector. B is stamped below operating rod. Stamped on rear sight mount are N407. 2, B6, and 2 are stamped on front sight. K5 is stamped on upper hand guard. The wpn has a folding spike bayonet and L2 is stamped on bayonet snap lock. Also cptrd were 30 7.62 mm, type 56 cartridges with head stamps as follows: 31/65, 31/66, 31/67. Wpn was manufactured by Communist China.

d. On 121000h Dec 68, via coord AT960655, Project Delta elms cptrd the following:

(1) Two 7.62 mm, type 56, assault rifles (sn. 12069640, sn. 11102054). The wpsn are standard issue assault rifles of late version. Stamped on left side of the receivers are 66 in a triangle, 3 Chinese characters, and the serial numbers. Stamped on the right side of the receivers are L and U forward of fire selector, and B forward of the operating rod. Weapon with sn. 11102054 has letter S stamped on the selector. The last 5 digits of the serial numbers are stamped on the receiver covers, on the operating spring guides and on the bolt carriers. O is stamped on bottom of the bolts. Wpn with sn. 11102054 has CB9 stamped on the bayonet release, K25 and 2 stamped on upper hand guard, D57 stamped under rear sight, 2, D, and 26 stamped on front sight. 'R 62 is stamped on top of the receiver under the cover. Wpn with sn. 12069640 has D stamped on upper hand guard, 2 stamped on front sight, and 72 stamped on the receiver under the cover. Both wpsn have folding spile bayonets.

(2) Commo wire. The wire is 1000 m (two 500 m doughnut rolls) in length, 2 by 7/6.25 mm in size, dated 14 July 1968. The above data was extracted from tag attached to each 500 m roll. Numerous Chinese characters are stamped on these tags. The insulation on the wire is dark blue, single layer plastic. It is a single wire constructed of three copper and four steel strands. Wire was manufactured by Communist China.

(3) 180 T-36 (1 rd is unidentified) 7.62 mm cartridges with 31/65, 31/67, 41/67, 71/66 and 71/62 head stamps

e. On 221405h Dec 68, via coord AT966600, Project Delta elms cptrd 1 anti-tank grenade lnchr (type 56, sn. 121212). On the left side of the firing assembly, directly above the serial nr, are the nrs 56-400, with encircled 51 stamped below the serial nr. The serial nr is also stamped on the firing contact housing above the trigger. A star with the nr 5 in its center, is stamped above the left side grip. 7-8-18 is stamped on the bottom of the pistol grip. 4/2C is stamped on the trigger and 5/2C is stamped on the housing above the trigger. Lnchr was manufactured by Communist China.

f. On 292345H Dec 68, via coord AT001677, Project Delta elms cptrd the following equipment:

(1) Two 7.62 mm, type 56, assault rifles (sn. 11045850, sn. 11062X39). Wpsn are standard issue assault rifles of late version. Stamped on left side of the receivers are 66 in a triangle, 3 Chinese characters, and the serial nrs. Stamped on the right side of the receivers are L and D fwd of fire selector, and B forward of operating rod. The last 5 digits of the serial nr are stamped on the receiver covers, on the operating spring guides, and on the bolt carriers. Wpn with

SN 11045850 has 0 stamped on bottom of the bolt, 7 stamped on upper hand guard, N3 stamped under rear sight, 811 and 2 stamped on front sight, and 14 stamped on top of the receiver under the cover. The folding bayonet has been removed. Weapon with SN 11062039 has S stamped on fire selector, 442 stamped on the folding spike bayonet release, CE30 stamped on upper hand guard, 1107 stamped under rear sight, 9 stamped on front sight, and 122 stamped on top of the receiver under the cover.

(2) Cartridges (556): 7.62 mm, type 56 with head stamps as follows: 31/65, 31/66, 31/67, 31/63, 31/57, 31/64, 61/62, 61/67, 71/62, 71/58, 71/65 btwn 9 and 12 o'clock positions, RFR, in the 3 o'clock psn, 22 with 63 in the 6 o'clock psn. The cartridges were in 14 AK magazines with the remainder looses in pockets of cartridge belts.

(3) Anti-tank grenade lnchr (1) It is a type 56 anti-tank grenade lnchr with SN 111560. On the left side of the firing assembly, directly above the serial number, are 3 Chinese characters, and 57 stamped below the serial nr. The serial nr is also stamped on the firing contact housing, above the hammer. A star with the nr 5 in its center is stamped above the left side pistol grip. Stamped on the bottom of the pistol grip is 6-8-56. Stamped on the housing, above the trigger is 5/20. Stamped on the rear end of the barrel is 450718.

(4) Anti-tank grenades (4): Type: ChiCom type 50 HEAT. The grenades are standard issue with propellant charges. Chinese characters were legible on grenades; however, other markings were not legible.

(5) hand grenade (1): Type, ChiCom, stick-type (defensive).

g. On 100900H Jan 69, vic coord YT275795, Project Delta elms cptrd a 7.62 mm, type 56, assault rifle (SN 12047683). The wpn is a standard issue assault rifle of late version. Stamped on the left side of the receiver are 66 in a triangle, 3 Chinese characters, and the serial nr. Stamped on the right side of the receiver, fwd of the fire selector, are L and D, and B fwd of the operating rod. The last 5 digits of the serial nr are stamped on the receiver cover, operating spring guide, and the bolt carrier. Also 9 is stamped on the operating spring guide. The nr 3 is stamped on the lower stock mounting support. Stamped at the rear, on the upper hand guard, is the ltr O. Stamped below the barrel, on the gas cylinder mount is the nr 338 and the ltr I. The number 2 is stamped on the front sight. The wpn has a folding spike bayonet. Also cptrd were 134 type 56, 7.62 mm cartridges with head stamps as follows: At 12 and 6 o'clock psns are 31/56, 31/58, 31/62, 31/63, 31/64, 31/65, 31/66, 31/67, 61/67, 71/62, 71/62, 81/64, 17/K (cyrrilic K). Wpn was manufactured by Communist China. Remarks: It is believed that some rounds were manufactured by Russia.

h. On 121515H Jan 69, vic coord YT295740, Project Delta elms cptrd a 7.62 mm, type 56, assault rifle (SN 3064127). The wpn is a standard issue assault rifle of late version. Stamped on the left side of the
